# MESSAGE from the President



*hope realized*

**EACH NEW SCHOOL YEAR**, regardless of the conditions, brings a feeling of hope. Teachers, staff members, coaches, our students, and their families all look at the new school year as a

fresh start. At the start of the 2022-2023 school year last August, we were hopeful that we would be able to create a greater number of opportunities to form community — and in so many ways, those hopes were realized. We were able to return to Emmanuel Catholic Church for every all-school Mass; we celebrated the success of our sports teams and performing arts program; we welcomed eighth grade students from Our Lady of the Rosary School to CJ's campus; we witnessed students joyfully experiencing dances, concerts, pep rallies, and an outstanding talent show; we proudly watched our seniors present their capstone projects at the Sister Dorothy Stang Symposium; and we made plans to welcome the largest number of new students in more than a decade to campus this fall.

And, because of the support of the CJ community, we were able to advance elements of the campus master plan including the renovation of 300 Perry Street into the Founders Center and the demolition of Marianist Hall, the former on-campus residence for the Marianists, which had outlived its original purpose and useful life. With these projects, we are creating space for future developments that can more fully expand opportunities for our students by bringing the community's long-range vision for the campus closer to realization.

Several benefactors worked with the members of our development team to endow scholarships and tuition assistance to ensure that outstanding young people have the opportunity to benefit from the Chaminade Julienne Catholic educational experience. These scholarships support our students today and they also strengthen the long-term financial viability of the CJ mission by allowing us to look to the future with great confidence. We are grateful to these individuals and those who cared enough about the future to include CJ in their estate plans. Our future is getting brighter because of our community — alumni, parents, families, friends, foundations, and local businesses — a community whose support is enabling us to expand the impact of our mission in the greater Dayton region.

## Taking a pause

In the midst of the energy and excitement of another school year at CJ, we also know that we must periodically take time to pause — to be contemplative and, as Blessed Chaminade urged his brothers, “to read the signs of the times.” We seek to ask the right questions, both in prayer and in practice, and collaborate to discover the most appropriate answers. For us, the questions include: In what direction is the Holy Spirit calling the Chaminade Julienne community? What do the young people we serve need from CJ today and in the years to come in this post-pandemic era? What does our Church need from us? What does the Dayton region need of us?

With the guidance of our Board of Trustees and sponsorship by the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur and the Marianists, we address the big challenges through our strategic financial plan, campus master plan, and annual operating priorities and budgeting process. We believe that the Holy Spirit is calling us to more fully live out the call of the Sisters to “respect the dignity and sacredness of each person” and the Marianists’ call to provide “a quality, integral education.” So, we have accelerated our efforts to assure that all students, regardless of their culture, financial resources, and background, feel welcomed and included at CJ. We have added programs and services in recent years, like SOAR (Students Owning Accountability and Respect), a program to create space for small groups of students, led by a caring adult, to discover important life lessons of social and emotional learning, self-discovery, and building community; we expanded our college and career preparation program, available mental health counseling, English language services, and a college and career counselor to help students navigate the challenges of today and prepare for a future as lifelong learners and people of service, compassion, and faith.

We believe that our Church needs us to be bold in our faith, helping young people see, as St. Julie Billiart saw, “How Good is the good God!” Despite the imperfections and polarization of the world, our Church needs us to help students come to understand that through their faith, they can better understand how God is calling them to use their gifts and talents in serving others to make our world more just, more kind, more representative of the coming of the kingdom of God. If they come to understand this, they will help the Church grow and navigate the challenging times ahead.

We believe that this region needs Chaminade Julienne to thrive, to continue to be the place where students from all parts of the region — and, increasingly, the world — come together to learn, play, pray, and mature. Our contribution to the community is graduating outstanding young people who know how to form community, who know the importance of working together no matter your differences, and who understand the responsibility to participate in civic life and use economic systems for the common good.

### The journey

And, what do our students need? They need our outstanding teachers, dedicated coaches, and caring staff members to genuinely accompany them on their journey of high school, which represents just four years in their lifelong journey to holiness. It may only be four years, but the adolescent years can and should be impactful as students mature from an elementary understanding of the world and their call to discipleship to a more mature understanding of God's call for them. Our mission is so critical because these four years are such a significant time in their physical, faith, academic, and social development. It's when they recognize the importance of service to others and becoming a person who will make a positive difference in the world.

At CJ, we walk with students as we challenge them to be the best person they can be while helping to shape their worldview. This is accomplished by creating an environment that welcomes each student — a supportive and predictable environment. We cannot clear all the roadblocks or straighten the path they need to journey. Our mission is not to protect them from the world, but to help them move through the world with the skills they need to navigate what's ahead.

### Pope Francis said:

"Journeying is precisely the art of looking toward the horizon, thinking where I want to go but also enduring the fatigue of the journey, which is sometimes difficult. . . What matters in the art of journeying isn't not falling but not staying down. Get up right away and continue going

forward. This is what's beautiful – this is working every day, this is journeying as humans. But also, it's terrible walking alone: It's terrible and tedious. Walking in community, with friends, with those who love us, that helps us. It helps us to arrive precisely at the destination where we must arrive."

And he said, "Always remember this: life is a journey. It is a path, a journey to meet Jesus."

This is what the CJ mission calls our teachers, coaches, staff members, and volunteers to do - to engage in the journey with our students so authentically that their presence remains long after the four years of high school have been completed. In conversations with alumni, they often share stories of the impact a Chaminade or Julienne or St. Joseph or Chaminade Julienne teacher had on their high school experience and ultimately their life. The same thing happens today. I respect, honor and believe in the passion of those at CJ who walk the journey with our students. They create an environment of support for students that will last beyond graduation.

God brought all of us here - parents, students, teachers, staff members, supporters and friends who make this mission possible — at this time together to help these young people develop and take what they have learned out into the world. Our path forward can be made clearer when we recognize our more than 170-year history of advancing and overcoming, see milestones like the 50th anniversary this fall of the uniting of the Julienne and Chaminade missions in 1973, and seek the continuing guidance of the charisms and traditions of the Marianists and the Sisters.

What a privilege it is for us to walk this journey together, to see the impact of your contributions in the lives of those we serve, and to know that we are all changed by our shared mission to provide outstanding opportunities for this generation of young people and those we will serve in the years to come.

# Development Summary

**This year's development work** centered on advancing progress via several capital projects, strategic initiatives and engaging benefactors in the process of shaping development priorities. In creating opportunities to meet with alumni outside of the Dayton region, the development team hosted alumni-gathering events in several cities: Cincinnati, Louisville, Nashville, Atlanta, and New York. These outreach efforts, combined with our traditional events such as the Lucas Pfander Run, President's Leadership Reception, Scholarship Breakfast, Last 5 Luncheon, Athletic Hall of Fame, Distinguished Alumni Dinner and Reunion Weekend, ensured that our CJ community had many opportunities to celebrate this special CJ family.

New initiatives included the Alumni Directory project. As part of the move of archives to Founders Center, yearbooks were made available to alumni which resulted in more than 115 alumni renewing their connection with their alma mater.

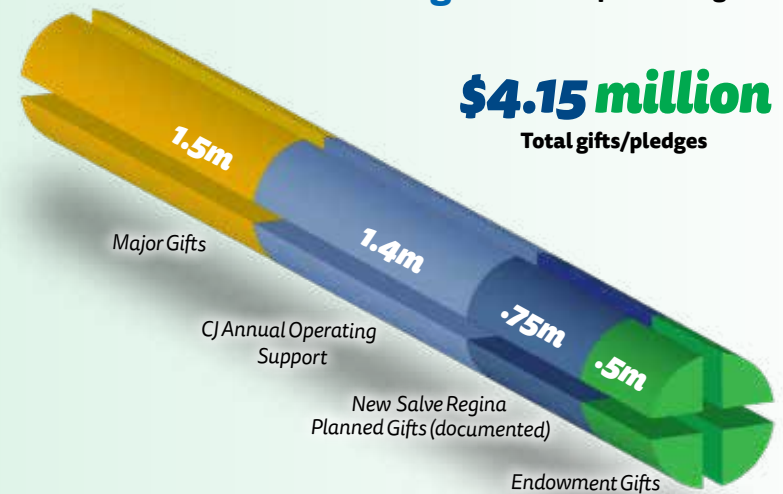
**This year's progress towards our strategic priorities in 2022-2023 resulted in \$4.15 million of support:**

In 1995, if a CJ student wanted to share a playlist of songs with their friend, they would probably record their favorite songs from the radio onto a cassette tape. Today they just call out to their smart device and a station full of their favorite songs is ready to share instantaneously.

The world has changed, and change is happening more quickly than it did even 10 years ago.
