Department Highlights

- ✓ Four school concerts are presented throughout the year which include performances from all of our band and choir ensembles, including concert band, concert choir, instrument ensembles, Hands In Harmony, Busted Box Improv Troupe, a capella groups and liturgical choir.
- ✓ In addition to participating in many CJ events, band and choir ensembles and groups perform throughout the greater Dayton community. Past performances have included the Brunner Literacy Center Walk (band), Dayton Homeless Vigil (choir), and Red Ribbon Day at Our Lady of the Rosary. We participated in the grand opening celebration of the Levitt Pavilion in downtown in July 2018.
- ✓ Band and choir students have been nominated and selected for numerous honor bands and choirs throughout the tri-state area.
- ✓ In addition to leading musical worship at school Masses and Baccalaureate, liturgical choir also takes part in community events, such as Angels Night at Calvary Cemetery.
- ✓ Two drama productions each year including a fall play and a spring musical. Recent shows have included *Tartuffe!*, *The Odd Couple*, *Once On This Island* and *Godspell*. Performers and staff were celebrated in the Dayton Awards with numerous recognitions.
- ✓ CJ's improv troupe Busted Box, participates local competitions and hosts a showcase for area schools.
- ✓ Performing arts students travel to Walt Disney World in Orlando, Fla. to perform and participate in educational workshops.
- ✓ We provide outreach to grade school students through our continued partnership with Our Lady of the Rosary to enhance their general music program, and provide workshops for area grade schools.
- ✓ Our staff teaches Musical Theatre summer camp as part of the CJ Eagles Summer Camp program.
