

## College Credit Plus Participation 2019 – 2020

### Step 1: Secure Funding

1. Before March 31: Discuss CCP plans with your counselor
2. February 15 – April 1: Submit [letter of intent](#) to the state
3. February 15 – April 12: Parent creates a [SAFE account](#)
  - a. [Video](#) to create a SAFE account
  - b. [Video](#) to set up access to the College Credit Plus system (in SAFE account)
  - c. [Video](#) to create an application for College Credit Plus (in SAFE account)
  - d. [Video](#) to verify user identity (*only needed if parent does not have an Ohio's driver's license or Ohio identity card*)
4. February 15 – April 12: Apply for funding through the SAFE account. Be sure to apply for enough funding to cover the course credit hours, not the number of courses
5. Before May 17: Funding award notifications sent. The notification will be in the parent's SAFE account under the AWARD DETAILS tab.

### Step 2: Be Accepted to the College/University

\*In order to submit the funding application, acceptance letters from the college(s) must be uploaded in the parent's SAFE account. Therefore, it is *highly recommended* to apply to the college(s) and complete placement testing ASAP

If taking CCP classes taught at CJ, student will be registered by CJ</li> <li>e. ACT/SAT scores, if available</li> <li>d. If no qualifying ACT/SAT scores, student must take Sinclair's placement test(s)</li> </ol> </li> <li>4. See the ACT/SAT and placement score requirements on Sinclair's CCP website. Students must achieve these scores to be eligible to take CCP class through Sinclair</li> <li>5. Students will receive an acceptance letter with the next steps to complete the orientation and registration process</li> <li>b. Provide Sinclair's CCP office a copy of the funding letter</li> <li>c. If taking CCP classes taught at CJ, student will be registered by CJ</li> <li>d. If taking CCP classes at Sinclair or online through Sinclair, contact Sinclair to register for classes</li> </ol> </li> </ol> <p>*If you are taking CCP classes through Sinclair during the 2018-2019 school year, you do not need to reapply</p>

- AP US History (Sinclair Community College HIS 1101 & 1102 — 6 semester hours)
