



Frequently Asked Questions - New Parents at CJ

School Day Questions:

- Q: When is new student orientation and the first day of school?
- A: New student orientation is August 19, from 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. and the first day of school is August 20.

- Q: When is the school open for early arrivals? How late may my child stay at school? Are there after-care options?
- A: The school doors open at 7:00 a.m. each school morning. After school, CJ runs the Eagles Learning Center from 3:30 -5:00 p.m. which is free and open to all. The campus map, including the drop off / pick up zone on Franklin St. can be found here: <https://cjeagles.org/about-cj/campus>.

- Q: How do I notify CJ that my child is sick and will not be attending school, or that my child needs to leave school early for an appointment?
- A: Contact the Office of Student Services at (937) 461-3740 x465 for all attendance needs. A message can be left in Spanish if your child will be out sick or if you need to come in early and pick up your child for an appointment.

- Q: Where can I find the school calendar, information about school uniforms, school lunches, and the school nurse?

Grinders, and all health forms from the school nurse (some health forms are provided in Spanish versions).

- Q: How do I check my child's grades or find school supply lists?
