SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Chaminade Julienne Catholic High School is a private secondary school owned by the founding religious communities, the Marianists and the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur, and governed locally by a strong Board of Trustees. The school was founded in 1850 and has operated for 138 years at its current downtown Dayton location.

Students in grades 9-12 come to CJ from all areas of the region including 44 different zip codes and 29 public school districts. While most students are Catholic, students from other Christian and non-Christian faiths add to the vibrancy of the community. The student body is 39.8% Caucasian, 32.2% Black, 13.5% Multiracial, 12.2% Hispanic, 2.1% Asian, .4% other.

CJ seeks to make private education possible for any family wishing a high quality Catholic educational experience. In keeping with our founders' charisms and CJ's mission, students contributed more than 12,398 in volunteer hours last year. More than 28,017 men and women are graduates of the school.

COLLEGE ATTENDANCE

Of our 2024 graduates, 95.4% continued formal education, including 78.8% to four-year colleges and universities, and 14.6% to two-year colleges, and 2% to career and technical programs; 4.6% entered the military/workforce. The class of 2024 received \$18,160,210 in reported scholarships.
